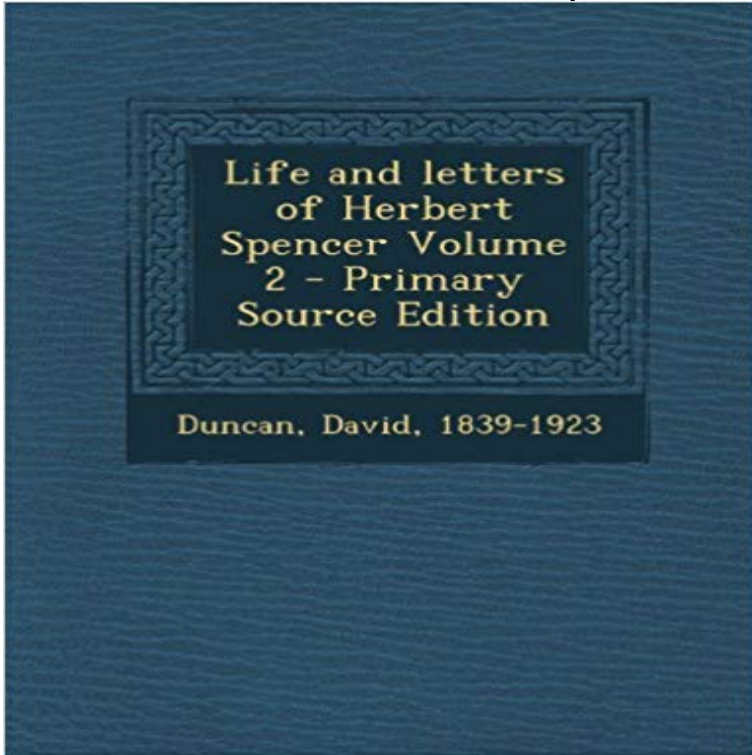


## Life and Letters of Herbert Spencer Volume 2 - Primary Source Edition
